Bush cucumbers produce big results in a small space. This easy-to-grow shrubby version of traditional cucumber vines lets small-space and container gardeners add a summer favorite to their vegetable gardens. Beginning gardeners can harvest a summer's worth of salads or an abundance of picklers to brine for winter enjoyment from only a few plants. Many of the cucumber varieties available in nurseries are vining plants, so look for those with the word "bush" somewhere in their name if you want to add one or more bush cucumber plants to your gardening.
